What We Do...

BBBSCI makes meaningful, monitored matches between adult volunteers (“Bigs”) and children (“Littles”), ages 5 through 14. We develop positive relationships that have a direct and lasting effect on the lives of young people. During the past year, BBBSCI served **555 youth** and celebrated **13 Littles** who graduated from high school. According to volunteers, parents, and teachers of Littles involved in our programs, **83%** of Littles improved their self-confidence.
